Lieutenant Colonel Toney R. Stephenson assumed command of the 902nd Contingency Contracting Battalion on 19 May 2015 and concurrently serves as the Deputy Director of the Joint Base Lewis-McChord office of the Mission and Installation Contracting Command (MICC) where he is responsible for the training and preparedness of military contracting specialists as well as providing oversight to contracting operations supporting a diverse joint customer base of Army and Air Force units and activities.

LTC Stephenson was commissioned into the Air Defense Artillery in September 1997 after graduation from the United States Army Officer Candidate at Fort Benning, GA. He was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 43rd Air Defense Artillery Battalion (Patriot), Suwon Air Base, Republic of South Korea, Charlie Battery, 1st Battalion, 56th Air Defense Artillery, Fort Bliss, Texas where he served as a Executive Officer. He later served as the Company Commander in the 1st Battalion, 15th Infantry Regiment , 3rd Training Brigade, Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri and Company Commander Installation Retrain Headquarters Company. Following this assignment he served two years as an Observer Controller and Trainer at Camp Shelby, Mississippi.

After joining the Army Acquisition Corps, LTC Stephenson's first assignment was with the 614th Contingency Contracting Team at Fort Benning, GA from May 2006 to October 2008 where he served as a Contract Management Officer. During this assignment he deployed in support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM serving Chief of Contracting Baghdad in the International Zone. From October 2008 to March 2011 LTC Stephenson served as the lead logistics and contracting planner in the US Army Central Command G4. He next served as the Chief of Operations, 410th Contracting Support Brigade, Fort Sam Houston, Texas where he was responsible for supporting US Army South Counter Transnational Organized Crime and Humanitarian Assistance operations. He then served as Chief of Contracting, Joint Task Force Bravo, Soto Cano Air Base, Honduras in direct support Central American operations. He then returned to the 410th Contracting Support Brigade to serve Executive Officer. He then assumed the Mission and Installation Contracting Command G2/3/5/7 to lead CONUS operational planning and execution in 32 installations. execution review and staffing support of contracting actions that required the approval of the Senior Procurement Executive. He is DAWIA Level 3 Certified in Contracting.

His military decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, the Meritorious Service Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the Army Commendation Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, the and the Army Achievement Medal with one oak leaf cluster.
