Shall the Board of Education of the Kelso C-7 School District of Scott County, Missouri, borrow money in the amount of Three Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$3,250,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the site development, construction, equipping, and furnishing of an elementary school building; and issue bonds for the payment thereof resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of \$0.75 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to increase from \$0.00 to \$0.75 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
